*SMUG began as a Stanford campus organization shortly after the release of the original Macintosh twenty years ago. Due to the growing interest in the community, the group moved off-campus. SMUG's current monthly meeting site, on SLAC campus, which is, the historic gathering site of the Homebrew Computer Club. In the mid-1970s, Homebrew was the nexus for many pioneers of the personal computer revolution, including two Steves—Jobs and Wozniak—who first demonstrated both the Apple I and the Apple II to their colleagues at Homebrew meetings.*
